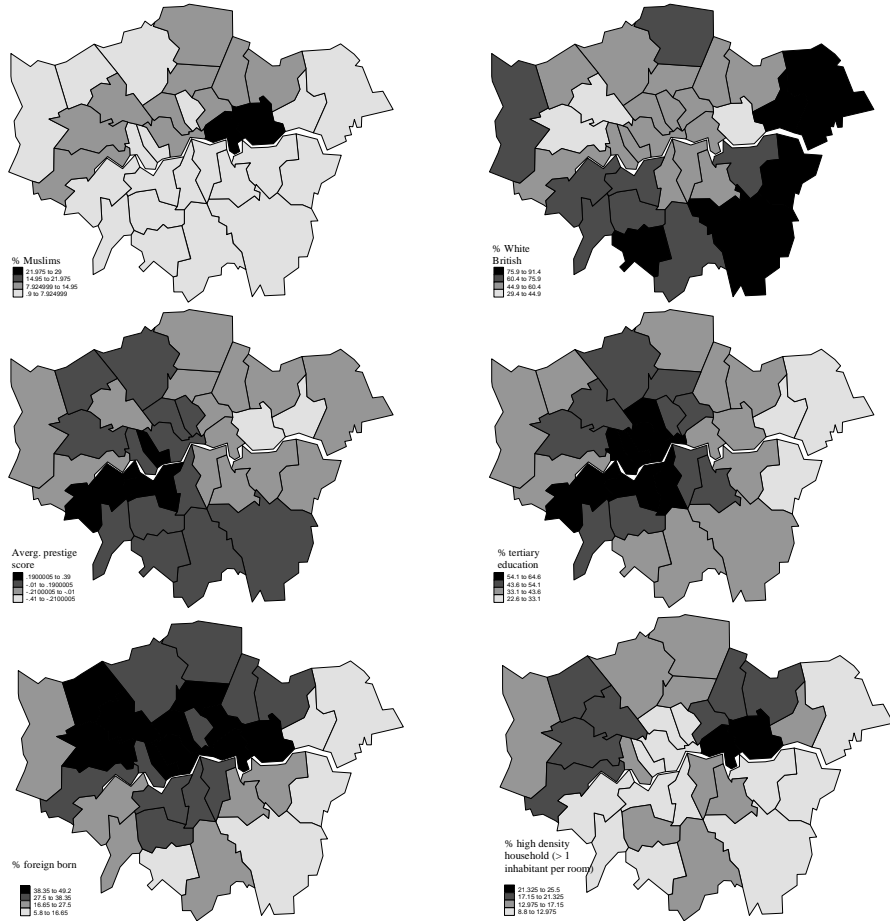


C- Occupational Prestige in Greater London boroughs



Question 2: Please answer 2 (TWO) questions of your own choice between this list of three:
 - After Durkheim, which are the four types of suicide? Which of them are the most relevant?
 - What is the “inversion of the gradient working hours – social class”?
 - What is the base of family cohesion today?

Please answer question 1 (50% of the mark) and question 2 (50% of the mark)
Question 1: Consider the individual’s prestige scores (based on occupations) of inhabitants of Greater London. Figure A gives the distribution of occupations. B and C present London’s social polarization of boroughs. D and E give descriptive statistics and a linear regression of the individual’s prestige scores.
 Are there strong differences between the descriptive distribution of prestige scores and the coefficients of the linear regression? Why? Which is your diagnosis on London’s inequalities? Are they based on “sociooccupational” divisions or on “ethnoreligious” ones. Please base your answers on the figures and on your own reflection.

A- Standardized prestige

A standardized (mean=0, Standard dev.=1) scale of prestige is created in Greater London. This scale is based on the economic level of the household.
